Who should attend? Anyone interested in solar development, land use issues and economic development in the greater Benson Area.

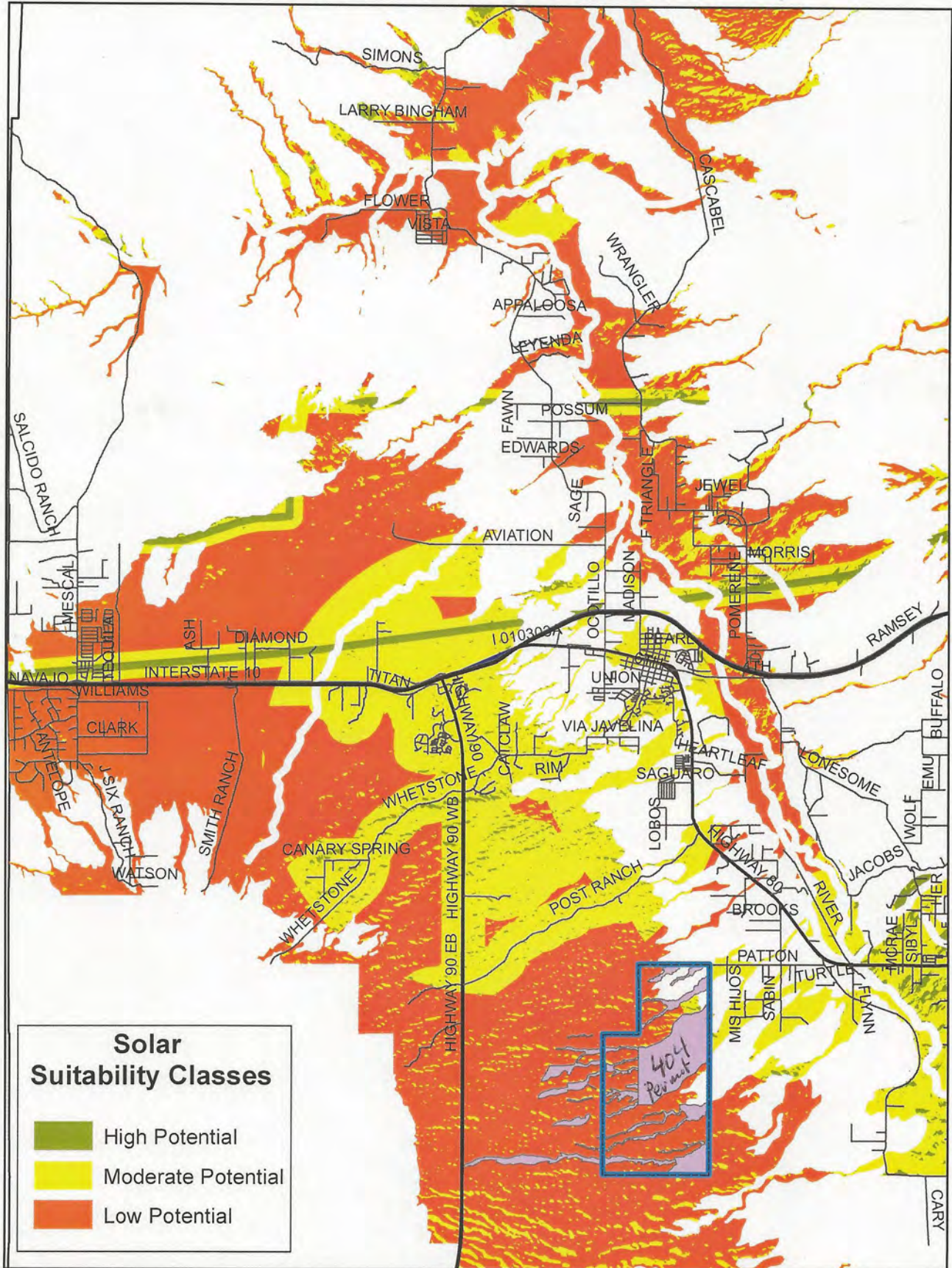
